FIRST EDITION. THE LIME INDUSTRY.

HAINE MANUFACTURERS MUCH EXCITED.

They claim that St. John Competition is ruining their business. A Rockland despatch to the Boston Advertiser says: The people in this city and Rockland, and in fact in all Knox County, are stirred up about the duty on lime. It is a serious, not a vital matter to Knox County, whether or not the increasing competition from St. John, N. B., lime burners is to be checked or not. The existing duty, which is practically 3 cents per barrel, is wholly inadequate, and so far as protection from it is concerned, lime might as well be on the free list. The ways and means proposed have been made in 1887. The situation is real light, and they propose to make the duty equivalent to 13 cents per barrel. What disturbs the people here is the attempt made by the agents of the St. John concern in Boston and New York to defeat the proposed increase. The people of Knox county are greatly interested about the increased duty. Lime manufacturing, or burning, as it is called, is the only productive industry here, and it is gradually slipping away from the control of Rockland and Rockport manufacturers under existing circumstances. The business employs several hundred hands, and over \$2,000,000 is invested in it. The 40 or more firms turn out about 2,000,000 cases per year, and have a capacity greatly in excess of that amount. The campaign against Knox County interests is being made upon an unfair and incorrect basis, and proceeds directly from St. John. It is being said, where the lime is increased, it will influence anyone that the increase of duty is sought by the manufacturers who are in combination and are already over-producing, and that the object of the increased duty is to permit the combination to increase prices. The circulation of a petition setting forth the true state of affairs and protesting against the increase in duty has received many signatures which would not have been granted had the facts been known. A committee of nine issues a circular from time to time advising as to production, and the lime is a perishable commodity, and an over-production is a bad thing, as the experience of 1887 proved. There is no profit, no penalties, and no dividends. The manufacturers have capacity for double the consumption of the whole country, and some have the power to produce in excess. The price of lime is nominally maintained by the combination, but not actually, and the claim that price is now maintained by the combination and act to be increased if the duty is increased is a fiction. Knox county lime burners are not fighting for higher prices, but for existence. Here is the situation. A few years ago parties from Maine began lime burning in St. John. Prior to that time, American lime had been exported to the provinces, but the American capitalists who had begun business in St. John, including a leading Maine manufacturer, were strong opponents of the state of the business there, soon revolutionized the business there by the introduction of the best improved American type of kiln, and cheap labor and cheap fuel, but chiefly owing to the labor issue, because the cost of lime is over 90 cents per ton, and the cost of the lime is over 100 cents per ton. The lime manufacturers began to compete in all American markets with Knox County lime, and the competition has become so great that, in some places, the fight of the Knox County manufacturers for existence.
