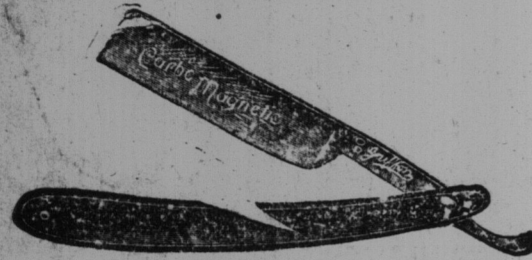

TOKIO, July 7.—The Japanese gunboat Kaimon struck a mine and sunk in Tatten Wan Bay on July 6th. The Kaimon was a small wooden steamer, 29 years old, carrying light guns and about 230 men. CHICAGO SAVES \$8,000,000.

Court Decides that 'Iroquois Fire Sufferers Have No Claim Against the City.

CHICAGO, July 7.—Litigation to the probable aggregate total of \$8,000,000 has been discouraged by a ruling of Judge Holden, in the superior court, to the effect that the city of Chicago was not liable in any degree for the Iroquois Theatre fire. A suit by Eva Catherine Gibson for \$5,000 damages because of a broken arm and an injured spine was the case decided. Sixty other suits are pending, and had the decision been against the city, hundreds of other actions probably would have been filed.
