I have the honor to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 2nd Inst;- And previous Letters. In regard to refund from Canadian Bank of Commerce, and Canadian Oil Co,

And in reply to same, I have to report that I have had quite a time in getting this matter straightened out, and in the case of the Canadian Oil Co, The Account was taken care of by the Farm Instructor at Manitou Rapids Indian Reserve, and in checking back all Invoices and Advices of Oil Supplied, during the Year 1935, I find that we still Owe the Canadian Oil Co, the Sum of \$90.55, which I will have to out of this Years Advance for Farm Work on the Manitou Rapids Reserve,

Enclosed you will find Cheque in favor of the Receiver General of Canada, which takes care of the Refund on Revenue Stamps and Refund on Barrells, which is the mentioned in your letter of the 2nd Inst;-

I am very sorry that it has taken me so long in getting this matter straightened out, but owing to corresponding and checking back for the Year, it has delayed me making the refund asked for in your letter,

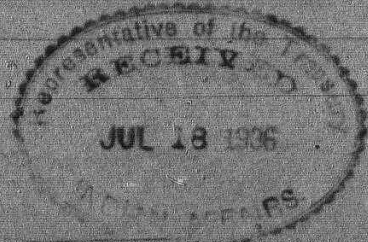
