**Rotary Attains
Seventh Birthday**
Former President Dykeman
Gave Interesting Sketch of
Club's History.

The weekly luncheon of the Rotary Club on Monday, was the anniversary meeting, the Club having been formed on 2nd May, 1914. Rotarian Chas. W. McKee was chairman for the occasion, but the holiday made some little difference in the attendance.

President Spangler urged upon members the absolute necessity of attending each weekly meeting, if the Club was to maintain its excellent position among the several clubs in the district in the matter of attendance. Some few members had become very slack in this respect, and their absence pulled down the weekly average.

Rotarian Weyman reported that he was in receipt of a letter from the Provincial Treasurer of the Boy Scouts, thanking the Club for the valuable assistance rendered by it to the Scout movement.

The suggestion of the committee that each member as his birthday came round should make a donation to a special fund to be offered to Child Welfare or such other object as should be decided on, was adopted by the meeting.

Rotarian Dykeman then gave a very interesting sketch of the Club since its inception seven years ago. It commenced with twenty-eight charter members, of whom, however, only Rotarian F. A. Dykeman, H. W. Rising, H. G. Marr and A. G. Everett are still with it. Much of the success which the Club has since achieved is due to the good work done by its first members, and particularly the energetic secretary, Arthur M. Phillips, who later went overseas. Many members of the Club followed his example, who therefore became lost to Rotary. Since its inception the Club has broadened and taken on new ideals, and now has a membership of ninety-eight.

**FREE TRADE
WOULD RUIN
THE DOMINION**

"Do you know that in this country today, take it on the average—and we have had it investigated—our farmers are getting their implements just as cheaply as in corresponding points in the United States. Does anybody think that we ought to pursue a policy in this country that is going to bring into effect termination of the farming industry of this Dominion by the great price of the U. S. Do you think we should do that, even if we reduced by a dollar or so the price of farming implements here?"

Situation is Critical
"But if the next place do you want this country to be in the position it is sure to be in in a very short time; if you throw all these articles on the free list? Take the countries of the world. You won't find one of them where implements can be bought as cheaply as United States and Canada, and in both of these countries the industries have been built up under a protective tariff. Let me deal with it in just a little wider way. I mention the Fordney-Young tariff that is now going into effect in the United States. It is against the whole world. It is not just against Canada. They are doing this because they think it is best for them. There are those who try to preach to you that it is because we are not doing it right. Not so, they are punishing every country as well as us. It is not to punish anybody; it is to help themselves. Do you know the whittlings of trade between us and the United States. Do you know we are buying more from that country than they are from us? This last year we bought \$184,000,000 worth of goods from them, and we sold them \$142,000,000 worth.

Trade Experiences
"Do you know what we were buying from them in 1917? In 1917 when the tariff party went into power we were only buying \$223,000,000—over \$300,000,000 of an adverse balance of trade between us in one year, and they are putting their tariff up so that they will buy less from us. AND WE ARE SOLELY TO BE TOOK FOR THE THING FOR US TO DO TO TAKE OUT OUR BARRIERS DOWN so that we will buy more than the \$366,000,000. I do not know that we ever sold that country in a single year anything like that. In 1917 we sold them \$110,000,000 and we are 9,000,000, so that every man, woman and child in the United States man and child in this country bought \$100.15, and Mr. Irvine and Mr. Stairs say the thing for us to do is to take our barriers down all along the line, so that we will buy more than \$100.15 apiece, and consequently they will buy less than \$100.15 apiece from us. Does it sound sane?"

Exchange Rate
"Before the war our money was at par because we borrowed the money overseas and paid the United States in their own coin. We were getting into debt. We did not borrow at home, as we did not through the Victory loans, and we did not have to buy American dollars at all. Now everybody knows that, except the C. R. C. The only way in the world we can correct this would be to produce more, sell more, and buy less.

"Last year it cost \$300,000,000 in exchange alone in the United States, and the way these people are thinking of remedying that is to buy less from the United States by taking down the tariff in order to buy more. I think you are just as capable of reasoning this thing out as I am. Look over the world today; look at France, look at Italy, look at Spain, Belgium, yes, look at Great Britain herself.

All Raising the Tariff
"They are going in about three months to do what the other countries are doing, and in every case the tariff since the war has been raised in those countries in order to stabilize the industries that were shaken and are now being readjusted after the war. Take Great Britain herself, which up to now is the only free trading country in the civilized world. What is Great Britain doing? Even in Great Britain they are resorting to other devices to protect their own trade. They are controlling importations—coal, bacon, beef, etc., and seeing to it that the home producer gets a show.

"In the face of all that, we are called upon by this Farmer party to take our tariff barriers down, to let the producers of every other country to behind tariff and then flood the markets of Canada with their surplus and destroy our whole industrial apparatus. I do not think we are going to do it."
