REPORT OF THE BOARD OF EXAMINERS.

The Annual Meeting of the Examining Board was held in the Main Street Church, Exeter, on the 22nd and 23rd of April, 1891.

Three probationers and six candidates for the ministry presented themselves for examination. Two candidates failed to reach the required standard. Two first and five second-class certificates were granted.

2. That the next meeting of the Board be held in Ridgetown.
