## COURSE OF INSTRUCTION.

LANGUAGES: ANCIENT—Latin, Greek.
Modern—French, German.

MATHEMATICS: Pure and Mixed.

NATURAL SCIENCE.

ENGLISH AND COMMERCIAL: Composition, History, Geography, Elecution, Book-Keeping, Music, Drawing, Gymnastics, Drill.

- The above courses are divided into Three Departments :-

I.—THE CLASSICAL DEPARTMENT.

II.—THE MODERN AND SCIENTIFIC DEPARTMENT.
III.—THE JUNIOR DEPARTMENT.

- (1.) In the CLASSICAL DEPARTMENT all those branches of knowledge are taught which are necessary to prepare Pupils for the Universities and the Learned Professions.
- (2.) In the MODERN AND SCIENTIFIC DEFARTMENT, the Course of Study embraces less Classics and more Mathematics, Modern Languages, English Literature, History, Geography (including Physical and Political), Composition and Book-Keeping.

Pupils are prepared for the Competitive Examinations for admission at Woolwich and Sandhurst, for direct Commissions in the Army and Navy; for the Civil Service, and for Mercantile Pursuits. Also, for the Gilchrist Scholarship, value 100% sterling per annum, and tenable for three years; open to all candidates who shall either be natives of the Dominion Canada, or reside there three years immediately preceding the Examination.
