

An Act to amend the Act 20 Vic., cap. 31, relative to the impounding of Cattle and other animals.

WHEREAS those provisions of the second and third sections of the Act passed in the twentieth year of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled "*An Act to prevent the cruel and improper treatment of Cattle and other animals, and to amend the law relating to the impounding of the same,*" which authorise the impounding of Cattle and other animals in places other than public Pounds, are likely to produce inconvenience and great injustice to the public; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

Preamble.

20 V., c. 31.

I. So much of said sections or of any part of the Act cited in the preamble to this Act, as authorises any person to impound or confine in any other place than the public Pound of the locality any Cattle or animals found trespassing is hereby repealed; And no Cattle or other animals found trespassing shall be impounded or confined except in the public Pound of the locality, and under and subject to such regulations as are prescribed by the By-laws then in force in the Municipality in which such trespass occurs.

Animals to be impounded only in Public Pounds.

II. This Act shall apply only to Upper Canada.
