2. The sixteenth sub-section of the twenty-seventh section of the said Act, is hereby so amended as to read thus:—

Powers of Local Councils, as to sale of liquors.

“16. Every Local Council may make By-laws, in the month of February or in the month of May, in any year, to come into force on and from the first day of May next after the passing thereof, and to remain in force until the first day of May next after the repeal thereof, for prohibiting and preventing the sale of all spirituous, vinous, alcoholic and intoxicating liquors, within the local municipality; and no revenue inspector shall grant any license for the sale of any such liquors within any local municipality where such sale is prohibited by any such By-law.”

How this Act shall be construed.

3. This Act shall be construed and applied, to all intents, as though embodied in and forming part of the said Act hereby amended; and the expression “*The Lower Canada Consolidated Municipal Act*,” or any other of those declared sufficient by the fourth section thereof, shall constitute a sufficient citation, as well of this Act, as of the said Act hereby amended.
