**Pornography pre-Christian says minister**

MISSISSAUGA — "The purpose of Pornography is to arouse lusts. Sex details are its main and only theme." So declared Mr. Art Dixon of Yonge Street Mission Youth Centre at Kenmuir Baptist Church here recently.

"Pornography is not modern—it is pre-Christian," he said. "But it is a modern-times expression. Why? Because there is a new kind of freedom of expression joined with a freedom to make money. Some writers sell their soul because Pornography brings in the money. Books selling in California for fifteen cents sell in Toronto on Yonge Street for four and five dollars."

The speaker further stated: "Pornography got a hold because of the decline of Christianity. Also, there is a false assumption that Science has overcome many of the results of immortality. For example, Venereal Disease.

"Pornography excites people to all sorts of perversions—perversions people have not even thought of. These include sadism and masochism which is brutality. The theatre helps flash these around the world."

Mr. Dixon predicted that pornography will get on T.V. And that, before long, Henry Miller, who is the leading pornographer today, will be accepted in the school textbooks. "This is possible because the school system is based on Humanism."

"No one can hear or look upon these things without being affected," he said. "Pornography says this is normal."

He restored perspective by quoting the words of Jesus from Matthew 5, 27 and 28: "Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not commit adultery but I say unto you, That whosoever looketh upon a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart."

**Sheridan entrance program began Mon.**

BRAMPTON — The summer program scheduled for the Brampton campus is the Sheridan College Entrance Program (SCEP) beginning July 6, and runs for eight weeks.

Earlier SCEP programs have concentrated on preparing students who lack a formal grade 12 education to enter technical courses. This year SCEP will also offer a program designed to assist the needs of prospective full-time business and general students.

Satisfactory completion of the technical SCEP program will allow students to register in Technology Division; successful graduates of the general program may be admitted to other divisions, subject to any special entrance requirements listed in the calendar.

Applicants must be 19 years of age or older and must have been self-supporting for at least one year.

There are no formal examinations and everyone is considered for registration in full-time courses at the end of the eight weeks.

Sheridan faculty member Vic Lenius will be director of SCEP this year. Tuition fees for either SCEP program are \$50 per student.

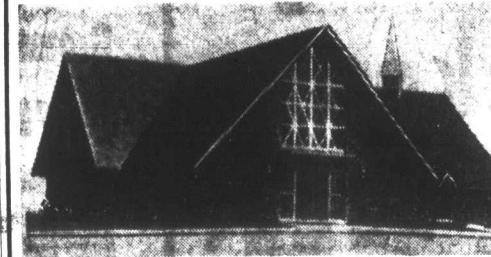

**Town able to hire family counsellors**

TORONTO — Municipalities will now be able to purchase the services of family counsellors and other experts to counsel and help families receiving municipal social assistance, the Honourable John Yaremko, Minister of Social and Family Services, said in the Ontario Legislature June 22.  
Existing Section 17 of the Regulations of the General Welfare Assistance Act lists the wide variety of counselling services which the Municipal Welfare Offices may provide with the assistance of the subsidy under the Act. These services include such things as counselling in respect of family or marital relationships, child care, parent-child relationships, money management, and other social services which may be required by welfare recipients.  
Prior to the amendment, municipalities that hired full time or part time counsellors, received a 50 per cent subsidy of the salaries and travelling expenses of these municipal employees. The amendment allows the same 50 per cent subsidy for the purchase of services, and enables the municipalities to have further access to federal funds under the Canada Assistance Plan.
