two months took in close confinancest, in a hosting, and under the continual approheusion of being executed in consequence of some misunderstanding which there exist hole between the two governments.

That on fleing exchanged in 1814, he wastent to place himself under the orders of bolonel Tourist at Lacole to command the Andidus; and that times that periods he has continued to area Sois Marsely as Captain and Interpreter residing at St. Pregis.

That considering the judomal dervices of your shittioner, as well as these of his family above entemerated, he confidently trusts your Excellency will, wouch stafe to take his present staff into couse deration, as he has been mady for years partly deferiored of the use of his limbs, and courequently fears to be totally in expanse of fulfilling the duties of the situation for that hither's helds under soverming environ to a source thumation, which he verily believes to have heards this week words with and other hards this he separationed in fring through the terrices above but forth, as well as the ill wage and privations he suffered in his confinement:

That the whole of the above alledged facts, can be proved by powers who have been eye witheful to the same, and that your Esculturey will find the freshit part of them duly certified by the documents a companying a certain faction of prehibited by your Petitioner to His decel line, Gir James Kempt in the months of o cloter or foreinter 1829.

That by the said petition, your petitioners fraged that to might be allowed to betire on the half pay of abastain, in the indian Department, the autiver of this bradley
