N.B. The Curtain rises at 8.15 p.m. The Auditorium doors will be closed as the curtain rises, and will not be opened again till the end of the Scene. This rule has been made in the interest and for the comfort of the Audience, and the Management earnestly invite your co-operation in carrying it out.

A gong will be sounded once, two minutes before curtain time, and again one minute before the curtain rises.

Smoking is strictly prohibited except in the foyer and passages; the fireman has instructions to secure compliance with this regulation of the London County Council.

A bookstall is placed in the foyer, and published plays, general books on the theatre, special Programmes of each Play and photographs of scenes and players in costume, may be obtained here or from the attendants.

The Management and the attendants are anxious you should receive the greatest courtesy; you will please both by reporting any failure in this respect.

Extract from the Rules made by the Lord Chamberlain: The name of the actual and responsible Manager of the Theatre must be printed on every play-bill. The public can leave the theatre at the end of the performance by all exit and entrance doors, which must open outwards. Smoking is not permitted in the auditorium. All gangways, passages and staircases must be kept free from chairs or any other obstructions, whether permanent or temporary.
