In reply to your letter of the 12th instant, reporting the application of Mr. Joseph A. Hill, for permission to cut some trees on the west part of his location, E.1/2 of W.1/2 of Lot 25 Con. 3, Tuscarora, I beg to inform you that a free Permit may be issued to him on the condition that he shall clear and fence the land and place it under cultivation the following season, or sow grass and clover seed thereon in sufficient quantity to prevent the growth of noxious weeds.
