J.F.Betts (Faying officer for Indians in Treaty 10) cheques in release of the savings of certain Indian pupils who, it is assumed, are at the Lae la Ronge Boarding School. Mr. Betts has written to say that it is not possible for him to hand these cheques to the payees, and he is therefore being asked to forward them to you in order that you may give them to the persons entitled to payment.

As far as is possible you should endeavour to have the respective payees expand the proceeds of the cheque judiciously.
