B E T W E E N:

GEORGE DANIEL JOHNSON of Amherst in the County of Cumberland, Pilot, hereinafter called the "Vendor" of the One Part,

WALTON ANSLIE ALLEN of Amherst in the County of Cumberland, Pilot, hereinafter called the "Purchaser" of the Other Part.

W H E R E A S

The said GEORGE DANIEL JOHNSON now carries on the business of a Flying School, charter service, aircraft dealers, service of aircraft, and dealers in parts thereof, at Amherst in the County of Cumberland, Province of Nova Scotia, in partnership with JOHN ANGUS MacNEIL of Amherst aforesaid, Pilot, the said business being known as MacNEIL and JOHNSON FLYING SCHOOL.

AND WHEREAS the said GEORGE DANIEL JOHNSON has agreed to sell all his right, title and interest in the said business, including his share in the building owned by the said partnership to the said WALTON ANSLIE ALLEN and the said JOHN ANGUS MacNEIL has consented to the said sale.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH that the said Vendor, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty-Five Hundred Dollars of lawful money of Canada paid by the said Purchaser to the said Vendor, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hereby sells and assigns to the said Purchaser as a going concern all his undivided one-half interest in the said business and the good will thereof together with the aircraft, building, stock in trade, fixtures, furniture and effects pertaining thereto as now carried on aforesaid, and also all book and other debts now due and owing to the said Vendor, both, on account or in respect of the said business, and all securities therefore, and also all contracts and engagements which have
