



PROCLAMATION,

BY HIS EXCELLENCY

Sir JOHN WENTWORTH, Baronet, L.L.D.

Lieutenant-Governor, and Commander in Chief, in and over His Majesty's Province of Nova-Scotia, and its Dependencies, &c. &c. &c.

WHEREAS the General-Assembly of this Province stands prorogued unto Thursday the 11th day of April next.

I have therefore thought fit, (by and with the Advice of His Majesty's Council) further to prorogue the said General-Assembly unto Friday the 7th Day of June next; then to meet for the Dispatch of Business, of which all Persons concerned are hereby required to take Notice, and govern themselves accordingly.

Given under my Hand and Seal at Arms at Halifax, this 25th Day of March 1799, in the 39th Year of His Majesty's Reign.
