An old prisoner of the Kaiser's was recently married in England. He is commander Vivian R. Brandon, R.N., one of the two British officers sentenced in December, 1910, to four years' detention in a German fortress for espionage.

The newly elected Mayor of Maidstone, who is a bachelor, and only 33 years of age, explained at a meeting of the town council that before he consented to accept office he was medically examined and declared unfit for military service.

Liverpool University has taken steps for the adoption of a new ordinance to enable the university to cancel a degree, a diploma or other distinction of any one guilty of conduct discreditable or detrimental to the university.

A case of interest to married men who joined the army for the duration of the war on faith of a promise of continued payment of wages by their employers, recently was decided in Belfast.
