OUR INLAND FISHERIES.

Some of the American sporting publications have this season been writing up the fisheries of Maine at the expense of the inland fisheries of this province. They have represented that state as presenting many more advantages in salmon fishing than in reality possesses, and have claimed for the sportsmen who have fished its waters, more success than they are entitled to. They attempt to depreciate the value of our privileges by representing them as ill protected, expensive, difficult of access, and as giving a meagre return. Chief among the publications thus engaged is, we regret to see, Forest and Stream, a paper generally well informed, and, in the past, disposed to represent facts within its field just as it found them. The secret of this onslaught, for such it is, on our fisheries lies in the influence of corporations and persons financially interested in the summer resort enterprises of Maine. All who take an interest in these sporting publications will regret to see that they have so placed themselves under the control of persons, to serve whose interests the reliability of these papers must be at least open to question, if not destroyed.

We do not object, nor will any New Brunswick object, to a comparison, consistent with the facts, of the advantages offered the sportsmen in the fisheries of Maine and this province. Such a comparison would be coured by our people. We object, however, to the deliberately false representation of our privileges that has already been made by Forest and Stream and its kindred publications. So far as these publications are concerned, what are the facts. Maine offers comparatively few advantages to the sportsman. Its rivers and its tributaries do not abound in salmon, nor are they protected for the benefit of its sportsmen. Any one is at liberty to fish wherever he may please; its fishing spots are common property, and in consequence have not the advantages of that care and attention to their interests demand. The result is that the sportsman has little reward for his labor. As an instance of this an American gentleman informed us a few days ago that he fished several of the streams in Maine, and did not average more than one salmon a day. These are facts that cannot successfully be disputed, and that do not justify the puffery and attention that has been given the Maine fisheries by American journals. How different is the case of New Brunswick. Salmon abound in its rivers, and particularly along the Restigouche and its tributaries are to be found in immense numbers. Its fishing privileges are leased to responsible persons, are well protected, and regularly inspected by one of the best informed sportsmen in America, Mr. J. J. Phair. The result is that the sportsman has good reward for his labor. Salmon are fished from its streams in plenty. Not long ago a gentleman fished from the Restigouche in three days and a half thirty-five large salmon, and a few days ago Mr. Farintosh, an American, killed in twenty-three pounds each. Other such instances could be furnished. We claim for the fisheries of the Restigouche better results than can be obtained in any part of the United States; easy access and all comparatively trifling expense. Of the truth of this few are

better informed than Forest and Stream. If, therefore, that journal expects to occupy in the future the high place in the estimation of its readers and sportsmen generally that it has in the past, it must cease to cater to the personal interests of the proprietors of the Maine summer resorts until such times at least, as the advantages of their fisheries will allow them to make good their claim.

These recent attacks on our fisheries suggest at least one thing: that our local government should take some proper means to make our advantages in this respect better known to American and Canadian sportsmen. The government is now, under its policy, and through the carefully management of Mr. Phair, rearing a nest of vipers from these fisheries. If they were better advertised, and their advantages made more generally known, we have not the slightest doubt a greatly increased amount would be realized from them. We notice that several concerns in Maine have lately been issuing pamphlets descriptive of their fishing streams, and like Forest and Stream setting forth advantages which they do not possess. We even find in the pamphlets some of Taylor's views of New Brunswick scenes. For instance one of these views, on the Restigouche, is given as a view on the east branch of the Penobscot; another, Clear Water Mountain, as a scene on Mattawamkeag River; another Temiscouche Lake, as a scene in another portion of Maine, and so on. These pamphlets are widely circulated, and are the means of attracting many tourists to Maine. If a descriptive pamphlet well illustrated, and judiciously circulated, were prepared by the government next year much good would result therefrom. It would, no doubt, induce a rich class of tourists to visit our province. It would increase the revenues from our fisheries, and put in needed quarters the circulation of money. This is a matter the government should take into consideration.

NEWFOUNDLAND AND THE UNION.

It is stated that Sir Alexander Campbell has gone to Newfoundland on a political mission. His object, it is said, is to induce the people of Newfoundland to throw in their lot with ours. He is no doubt stimulated by Sir John and his colleagues, who are anxious that another province should be brought into the union, so that the mighty burden of our bearing may be to some extent lightened. He has also, no doubt, been encouraged by the federal authorities, who see in the union a simplification of the fishery negotiations.

Instead of our burden being lightened by Newfoundland coming into the union they would be greatly increased. The only industry of that island worthy of mention is fishing; the people themselves are the fish. They are not to be considered as a people, but as a source of food. They would be rendered still poorer by being under a government which places such a high tax upon the necessities of life. If Newfoundland should be brought into the union, it would be a short time before her people would raise the cry of secession as the sister province has already done. Newfoundland would count her own interest and that of the dominion by remaining in her present independent position.

Some of the more important conservative journals who opposed commercial union in the earlier stages of the agitation, and who have to a certain extent withdrawn their opposition, are now laboring to impress their readers with the fact that the agitation is not a party agitation; that they find many strong men in the conservative ranks have the proposed union, and so on. The Toronto News says:

Some of the Tory papers which jumped too quickly to small commercial union, under the impression that they had party at their backs, are having a momentary change of heart. They are now, in a manner, kind of a time with those ex-premier who, through conservatism, wait unrestricted reciprocity. The way the agitation has caught on among men of all parties, is the clearest proof that it is not a "Grit dodge."

What does this mean? Has the agitation already gained such headway that the conservative party as a party is forced to give it recognition? Is it obliged to accept commercial union as a good scheme? The smaller lights in Tory journalism will require to watch more carefully the turn of the wheel. They must keep themselves in line. It would of course be nothing uncommon for them to propose a scheme one day and to favor it the next. If we, however, are likely to have them with us in support of commercial union we must have a choice. We don't want the more notorious "fence jumpers." Their strength is wasted in getting over. They can do no good.

Sir John Macdonald, it would appear, does not relish the position he occupies in connection with the Kingston election petition. He is leaving nothing undone to escape trial. His dirty dealings, however, must come to the light of day. Last week we announced that an offer was made to Mr. Blake to withdraw the petition against his return for West Durham if the Liberals would drop the petition against Sir John. This proposition Mr. Blake unhesitatingly refused to accept. And they would learn from the Toronto Globe that Mr. Burdett, of East Hastings, was next approached, and with no better success. The Globe says—

There is scarcely an issue of the Montreal Star which does not contain some reference unfavorable to Premier Mercer. The Star has never anything to say against him, but the references to him show that the Quebec printer continues to be a thorn in the side of our Montreal contemporary.

SALISBURY AND THE UNIONISTS.

What the London Baiter says. The Post yesterday morning reiterated its cry for unity among the Unionists. It says: "A source of weakness will be apparent so long as Lord Salisbury is pelted to declare himself in a minority. A new appeal should be made to the Unionists to take their places in the ministerial ranks."

The News says: "Lord Salisbury has capitulated in terms that do honor to his cynical frankness. The government has betrayed the Irish landlords for the sake of union and office."

The Standard says: "The government can afford to treat with good humored indifference any criticisms that may be directed against it on account of the delay in avoiding offense to the connection of the Unionists and Conservatives in the Irish landlords for the sake of union and office."

NEWS CONDENSED.

The Royal assent was given to the Irish crime act amendment bill Tuesday. The Irish conservatives will not oppose the amendments to the land bill accepted by Salisbury.

Official returns show that 9,410 persons were evicted in Ireland during the quarter ended June 30.

Gladstone in a speech at Margate, Tuesday night, referred exultingly to the results of the recent elections. He said: "A most violent storm passed over Pittsburg last night, damaging property to the amount of about \$100,000."

It is reported that a change is imminent in the Turkish administration. Qurt Pasha, now president of the council of state, is becoming graver.

The Standard says (Paris, Kerry, Galway and West Cork will be proclaimed immediately under the crimes act and other districts if necessary.

The conservative candidates were elected yesterday for British division of Lancashire and Harnsey division of Middlesex, defeating two Gladstonians.

The senate has approved of the treaty of commerce between France and Mexico, embracing modifications of the articles demanded by the Mexican government.

The power of the Irish commissionaires to reduce judicial rents will be valid for two years, at the end of which time it is expected that a purchase bill will be in operation.

The Porte has sent a circular to the powers suggesting that Prince Ferdinand be made Governor of Roumelia and Regent of Bulgaria until the new Soudanese chooses a ruler.

A conservative meeting Tuesday night, the Marquis of Salisbury stated that the difference between the liberal unionists and the government, regarding the land bill, had been adjusted, concessions having been made on both sides.

The Afghan boundary question was settled yesterday. Russia receives territory between the Hindu Kush and Marghush rivers, accepting in return the English frontier line in Oxus river, and renouncing claims to the districts to which she would have been entitled according to stipulations of 1853.

According to letters from Bucharest, M. Decoutouly, French minister, in a speech at a banquet, said that the French republic was preparing a sanguinary struggle which would be more formidable the longer the outbreak was delayed. He concluded by offering to take to the health of the Russian minister, M. Contoul, whereupon all present shouted "Success to Russia, friends of France."

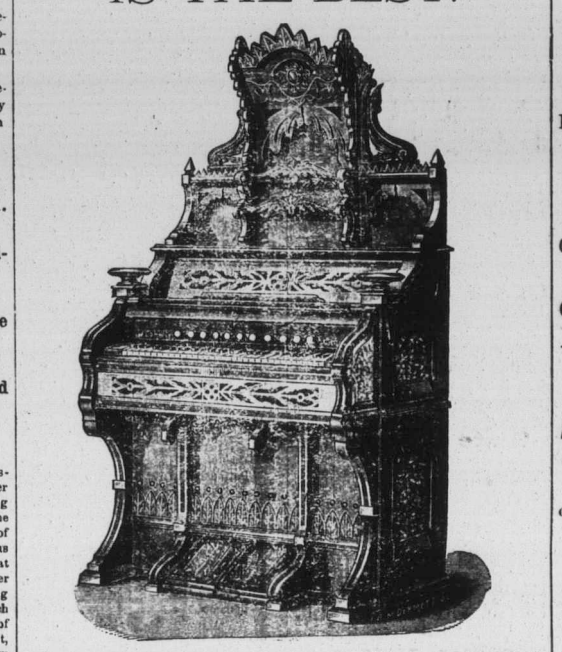
