

In politics there is much that is wholesome and much that might tend toward the furtherance of moral reforms. The price of a man's vote has a moral significance and consists in his interest to secure for the service of his country these men who are best fitted mentally and morally for the particular work of politicians. And it must be borne in mind that there is a distinct connexion between the moral and political elements of a government, not only so but it is vitally necessary that a man who aims at political life ought to be a man of some education, ignorance ing a very great limitation and is apt to make it impossible for a man to look beyond his own immediate and individual wants. 
