Mrs. Winttingham, M.P., on Man-Like Woman

"The Victorian Age was an age of bondage which began to terminate when women were allowed to express themselves as individuals, and it was not taken for granted that every woman was necessarily born a cook, any more than every man was born a picketer."

"Unfortunately, along with that freedom went the idea that it was a little unfashionable to know anything about housework—to sew, cook, or look after the home—and that the right thing for women to do was to go into the world and become man-like. I do not agree with that," added Mrs. Winttingham at a recent meeting of the Association of Teachers of Domestic Subjects.

"The greatest calling for a woman, she said, was to be a home-maker and to make the best use of her home. Twenty years ago, when cookery was introduced into a school with which she was associated, one child told the teacher that she was not to learn to cook because her mother kept a servant."

"Thank goodness that day was gone and they now recognized that the foundation of the national life was the home."
