RAIN SPOILS GOOD RACING AT WOODBINE
Events Were Keenly Contested Despite Sloppy Condition of the Track.
A CABLE FROM THE KING

Toronto, May 21.—The conditions for racing at Woodbine yesterday were about as uncomfortable and unseasonable as could be imagined, though it was not until after the second race that the rain came down. After that it did not cease, and was accompanied by a cold east wind. Their royal highnesses and Princess Patricia came down in motors to the club luncheon, and remained till 5 o'clock, the duke's flag floating from the staff in the infield until the royal party left the course.
The track was very sloppy, but there was keen and interesting racing, with plenty of horses engaged. Question Mark took the lead from Running Account in the opening race, around to the stretch. Then the pace-maker faded away until he finished fifth, behind Question Mark, Plantureux, Mud Sill and Chepotuc.
The good race that Captain Swanson ran on Saturday indicated him as a winner yesterday, and he came home in front of Scrimmage in the third race.
Mr. August Belmont's handsome Rock Sandilly Mission allowed little Mousant to make the pace in the Fashion Plate for five furlongs, and then she came on, winning handily.
The two-year-old selling race had the best, but he won only in the very last stride from the Hermis colt, Captain Elliott. The others were all strung out.
