Sarnia Presbytery.

The Presbytery of Sarnia held its De-The Presbytery of Sarnia field its De-cember meeting Tuesday, at 11 o'clock a.m., in the parlors in St. Andrew's church. The Rev. J. Burkholder, of Mandaumin, was elected moderator, and Rev. H. Currie, of Thedford, officiated as clerk. A large amount of business, most-ly of a routine nature, was transacted. A printed statistical and financial report

A printed statistical and financial report was presented, which showed that there are in the Presbytery 25 pastoral charges, embracing 48 congregations. There are 2740 families, an increase of 12° over the previous year. The number of communicants is 5,206, an increase of 224. The total amount of money raised for all purposes was \$52,077, being an average of \$19 per family.

The next regular meeting will be held on the first Tuesday in March, 1907, when the subject of church union will be discussed.
