The description of the first operation under ether in Europe as given by Dr. F. The subject was a man, thirty-six years old, whose thigh was amputated. The operation was successful, and Liston uttered the epilogue, "This Yankee dodge, gentlemen, beats mesmerism holler."



INSURING A NATION.

How It is Proposed to Wipe Out Want in England by Legislation.

Over in England 14,000,000 workers are now expectantly awaiting results from a bill of great proportions recently submitted to the House of Commons by Lloyd-George, Chancellor of the Exchequer. The bill stands great chances of being passed, and when that is done it will mean that Great Britain will become the dispenser of nearly \$100,000,000 a year to the working people, for it is a scheme of insurance that the bill encompasses.

In England the conditions of the working people are not as good as they are in this country. Often they are poorly paid and are forced to hunger and perhaps starvation when illness or accident takes them from their labors. It is this condition which Lloyd-George is attempting to ameliorate, and the national insurance scheme, it is believed, will help conditions greatly.

According to the bill every workman and work woman who earns less than \$800 a year will be compelled to pay a premium of 8 cents a week. Added to this the employer will pay six cents a week for every person who works for him and the state will contribute four cents a week. Then, when the person become ill and out of work, from the fund he will be entitled to the free services of a doctor and a money benefit of \$2.50 a week for three months. After that time he will receive half that amount for another three months.

Then there is another phase of the working life of Great Britain which Lloyd-George's bill will touch. The death rate among children of the poorer people of England is abnormally high. This is due to the fact that mothers, because of poverty, are forced to go back to work, sometimes a week after their children are born, thereby bringing about a condition of artificial feeding. Seldom is there enough money to buy good milk. Often the babies die of starvation or of neglect. To provide against this there is to be an insurance by which a price of \$7.50 is to be placed on the head of every infant and this will be paid on its birth, provided the mother stays away from work two weeks.

Then there is to be an insurance against non-employment—a tentative provision which is to be tried in two trades, engineering and building, and limited to 2,500,000 workmen. The employers and the employed are to pay five cents a week apiece, and then, when the worker is unemployed, he is to receive \$1.50 a week for 15 weeks.

Many of the manufacturers of England are fighting the bill; others are strongly in favor of it. England is not the first to use the national insurance. Germany for some time has had in effect a law which covers practically the same territory and it has been a success there. New Zealand, too, has tried the scheme with good results.
