INDICATIVE MOOD.

Present and Past.

Sin. 1. Chin-ilimigum, I am, I have been a chief. 2. Ku-ilimigum. 3. Ilimigum.

Pl. 1. Kae-ililimigum. 2. P-ililimigum. 3. Ililimigum. Ko-ilimigum, *On est chef.*

Present and Past continue.

1. Chines ilimigum, I am always chief, I remain chief. By adding *es* before the noun in the present.

Imperfect.

Sin. 1. Ue chin-ilimigum, I was chief. By adding *ue* to the present.

Future.

Nem chau-ilimigum, I shall be chief. As in the present, by prefixing *nem*.

Future Continue.

Nem chines-ilimigum, I will continue, remain chief.

SUBJUNCTIVE MOOD.

Present.

Sin. 1. Chikl-ilimigum, That I may be chief, I want to be chief. 2. Kukl-ilimigum. 3. Kl-ilimigum. Kokl-ilimigum, *Qu'on soit chef.*

Pl. 1. Kakt-ililimigum. 2. Pkt-ililimigum. 3. Kl-ililimigum.

Present Continue.

Chikaes-ilimigum, or, chikaes-ilimigui. 2. Kukaes-ilimigum. 3. Kaes-ilimigum.

Pl. 1. Kakaes-ililimigum. 2. Pkaes-ililimigum. 3. Kaes-ililimigum.

Past 1st.

Sin. 1. Lu lshei u chin-ilimigum, When I was chief, etc. From the present indicative.

Past 2d.

Sin. 1. Lu lshei n chin-uis-ilimigum, When I had done being chief, after I was chief. 2. Lu
