"All these savages go under the " name of Mickmakis. " the last war they could raise " about fix hundred fighting-men, " according to an account given " in to his most Christian majesty, " and were distributed in several " villages established on Cape-Bre-" ton island, island of St. John, on " both the coasts of Acadia (Nova-"Scotia) and on that of Canada. "All, or most of the inhabitants " of these villages have been in-" structed in the Christian religion, " by missionaries which the king " of France constantly maintains " amongst them. It is customary "to distribute every year to them " presents, in the name of his ma-" jesty, which consist in arms, am-" munition of war, victuals, cloath-" ing, and utenfils of various forts. "And these presents are regulated
