

CORN STARCH CAKE.—One-half cup butter, one cup sugar, whites of four eggs, one-half cup of milk, one cup flour, one-half cup corn starch. Flavour with almond, or to taste.

VEGETABLE SOUP.—Two pounds lean beef with bone (not cracked), three quarts water, adding more as it boils away; one teaspoonful salt; when the meat is cooked tender take it, with the bone, out, and add to stock one small carrot, one small turnip and six medium-sized potatoes, chopped fine. Save the meat for mince pies. We can heartily recommend this soup as the best of its kind.

BAKED MACCARONI.—Take one half package maccaroni and boil it until tender (usually twenty minutes), in salted water. Put it in an earthen baking dish, first a layer of maccaroni, then of grated cheese, letting the last layer be of the cheese. Add bits of butter, more salt if necessary, and turn milk over all. Bake until crisp on top, which will in a hot oven be about half an hour. This may be varied by using, instead of cheese, onions or tomatoes, and it is exceedingly nice with celery salt as the flavour.

Conching outlines now a days are usually thick strands of double crewe, filosselle, silk cord, or gold thread, used to finish the edges of appliques, or in gold outline work. These strands, cords or threads are caught down at regular intervals either by silks or fine gold thread.


