THE LATE FATHER STEFFAN.

The Accident Which Caused His Death-An Account of His Life.

The St. Mary's Sontinel of St. Mary's College, Kentucky, in its lest issue, contains the following account of the accident that befell Rev. John Steffan, formerly of Berlin Ont., but which unfortunately terminated fatally since the subjoined article was written. A very serious accident happened to Father Steffan on Oct 18th, which came near proving fatal. On his re turn from New Hope, where he had gone to assist the pastor, and in driving on the road along the railway track Father Steffan's horse became auddenly frightened by an approach ing freight train and dashed down a steep incline. The relitide was smarked against a tree and Father Steffan violently thrown on the hard pike, his elbow broken, hip and head seriously bruised, whilst the horse capack and ran several miles, giving the alarm. Father Steffan was found after an hour, still unconscious, and conveyed to the residence of Mr. E. L. Miles, where he was attended by Doctors Moore and Kelly. Under the kind and careful attentions of Mr. Miles family, Father Steffan was found a fair way of rec.very, when on Thuraday, the 28th inst., he had a stroke of apoplexy which rendered him speechless and completely paralysed on the right right side. Dr. Marvin of Louisville was called into assistance of the regular physicians, but for several days the Rev. Father's life was despaired of, until Nov. 1st, a decided change for the better set in and as we write we have hopes for his recovery, which will no doubt be effected if the good wishes and prayers of Father Steffan's many friends are heard.

Rev. John L. Steffan, C.R., Ph. D. D., was born in Buffalo, N.Y., about it years ago. He made his classic: course of five years studies at St. Jerome's College, and then went to Rome, Italy, in 1876, where he entered the Novinate of the Ocupregation of the Resurrection, and afterwards made a three years course of Mental Philosophy, and a four years ourse of Theology, othaining the degree of Doctor of Philosophy and Doctor of Theology, with honors at the Green death of the Coll
