

- (ii) Assess the efficiency with which all post programs are administered.
 - (iii) Assess the effectiveness of post use and deployment of financial, manpower and other resources.
 - (iv) Perform audits to determine the degree of compliance with established policies, procedures and regulations (e.g., in the areas of financial and personnel management and general administration).
 - (v) Advise on the adequacy of systems and procedures required by posts abroad to ensure effective management control of day-to-day activities and resources, and to facilitate assessments of efficiency and effectiveness.
 - (vi) At the request of ICER, participate in the review of design proposals for major new systems, policies and procedures and for significant changes thereto.
- (c) Program Evaluation
- (i) Review the effectiveness with which programs or activities at posts abroad are contributing to objectives prescribed by ICER.
 - (ii) Consult with the ICER Country Program Review Committee in their annual reviews of Canadian operations abroad.
