

- (e) Military Security Guards (MSGs) employed as Security Managers and members of an MSG unit at certain missions; also, on occasion, RCMP personnel required for close protection for Heads of Mission and other staff members;
- (f) Members of the Corps of Commissionaire employees engaged for security duties at Headquarters and, on a temporary assignment basis, at missions abroad; and
- (g) Locally engaged guards at a number of missions abroad.

COMMENT

Decisions as to the deployment abroad of Canada-based military and civilian security guards are based on operational, personal-safety and security-of-information considerations and are subject to change. In the past, for example, missions in "Scheduled Countries" tended to receive priority treatment in this regard.

1.4.7 Responsibilities of the Security Division

The Security Division (ISS) is responsible for:

- (a) advising on matters relating to personal safety at home and abroad;
- (b) advising on and ensuring the implementation of instructions and procedures relating to the protection of classified and other sensitive information and other assets including electronic data processing facilities;
- (c) establishing Departmental standards for physical protective measures at Headquarters and missions abroad consistent with governmental policy;
- (d) establishing Departmental standards for information technology security measures at Headquarters, elsewhere in Canada, and missions abroad consistent with government policy;
- (e) the procurement and maintenance of equipment to enhance document security, physical security and personal safety at home and abroad;
- (f) inspecting security and safety arrangements for the
