## MINISTERS FROM CANADA'S NEW GOVERNMENT TO PROMOTE CANADIAN OBJECTIVES AT THE WORLD TRADE ORGANIZATION

The Honourable David Emerson, Minister of International Trade, and the Honourable Chuck Strahl, Minister of Agriculture and Agri-Food and Minister for the Canadian Wheat Board will represent Canadian interests at the World Trade Organization (WTO) meetings in Davos, Switzerland, on January 26 and 27, 2007.

Canada will work with other WTO Members in support of the objectives of the WTO Doha Development Agenda negotiations and to ensure that we remain well-positioned to advance our interests, including defending our supply managed sectors.

Canada continues to support an ambitious outcome to the Doha round, as our economic prosperty depends on enhancing access to global markets for Canadian manufactured and agricultural goods, services and natural resources.

In Davos, both ministers will also hold a number of bilateral meetings to promote Canada's commercial and agricultural objectives with their counterparts.
