- **Spent fuel.** Fuel that after some time in a nuclear reactor is no longer effective for the production of energy needed for electricity generation.
- SSSF. Single Small Scale Facility. An SSSF is a facility that produces very small quantities of Schedule Chemicals for research, medical, pharmaceutical or protective purposes. Such facilities are permitted under the CWC but are liable to routine inspections.
- Verification. Verification measures, such as field monitoring and routine and challenge inspections, that provide confidence in compliance with international disarmament or non-proliferation agreements. On-Site Inspection (OSI) is an integral part of both the CWC and the CTBT.
- Zangger Committee. Group of nuclear exporters formed in 1971 to develop a common understanding on how, with respect to nuclear exports, to implement their non-proliferation commitments as set out in Article III.2 of the NPT. Zangger was the name of the first Chairman. The Committee now has 34 members.
