Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Republic of France concerning Cinematographic Relations, done in Ottawa on May 30, 1983, as amended by Exchanges of Notes done in Ottawa on February 8, 1989, on April 11, 1991, on September 8, 1992 and on October 25, 1997.

At the meeting of the Joint Cinematographic Commission held in Cannes on May 19, 1998, representatives of our two countries agreed to amend this Agreements. I therefore have the honour to propose an amendment to this Agreement in accordance with the Annexe to this Note.

If the proposed amendment is acceptable to the Government of France, I have the honour to propose that this Note and the attached Annexe, which are authentic in English and French, and your Excellency's reply to that effect shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments amending the Agreement mentioned in the opening paragraph of this Note, which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.
