Sir Arthur Currie, 2. therefore, at present that there is much chance that this College will include religious knowledge in the course of study leading to the B.A. degree at any time in the early future. There is always, however, room for one or two scholarly courses in the Philosophy of Religion if we only had a competent man to offer them. In any case it will be impossible for us to do anything in this matter until we have full particulars of the nature of the studies grouped together under the head of Religious Knowledge, and until we know pretty definitely who is to offer this instruction.
