within the limits aforesaid, the re-crection and repairs of the same, and the Building of new Barracks, Quarters, or Hospitals, where required; and who shall take care that the several Barrack-Masters do diligently fulfil the duties of their offices, and that Our Troops be regularly supplied with the different Articles of Furniture, Fuel, Candles, and other Stores to which they are, or may be entitled by the Regulations of Our Service: and You and Our Board of Ordnance are hereby vested with full powers, rights, and authorities for the same.

The Sums from time to time necessary for the service of the Barrack Department shall be provided for by Estimate, to be approved by the Commissioners of our Treasury, for the time being, and Annually submitted to Parliament.

Whenever there shall be a necessity for making Alterations or Repairs in Barracks, where such Alterations or Repairs shall exceed the sum of Five Hundred Pounds, you are, previously to carrying the same into execution, to cause an
