- (1) *To Lands (quare clausum fregit)*—continued.
 - onus of proof of title lies on *prima facie* trespasser, 443.
 - when surface and subsoil in different owners, 444.
 - to highways, *ib.*
 - of joint owners, *ib.*
 - carrying away of soil by one of two joint owners, 445.
 - reasonable working of coal mine by joint owner, *ib.*
 - injuries to party-walls, *ib.*
