15 7. (1) The Board shall have power to appoint such inspectors and other officers or employees as the Board may deem necessary for the purposes of this Act. (2) Any inspector or other officer when so authorized by the Board may enter upon any land, works or plant connected or installed upon any of the waters mentioned in section three or in or by which any such waters are used or diverted and take such measurements and do all such acts and things as may be necessary for the information of the Board as to the use or diversion of such waters by the person or corporation owning or controlling such land, works or plant.

25 (3) Every person who hinders or obstructs any such inspector or other officer in the performance of his duties under subsection (2) of this section shall incur the penalties mentioned in section four.

Penalty for

30 8. The Board and the members thereof and its officers and employees shall not be liable to any action for anything done by them or any of them under the authority of this Act.

Immunity from

35 9. The expenses of the Board, including the remuneration of the members of the Board, shall be paid out of such funds as may be appropriated by the Parliament of Canada and the Legislature of Ontario respectively for payment of expenses incurred for the purposes of this Act in such proportions as the Governor General in Council and the Lieutenant Governor in Council may agree.

40 10. (1) The Governor General in Council and the Lieutenant Governor in Council may make such regulations including provisions as to what shall constitute a diversion of the Board and how works of the Board shall be carried as they may agree to be necessary for carrying out the provisions of this Act.
