✕ JUNE—Salient idea, Summer.

✕ JULY AND AUGUST—

Ask the children to bring from sea-side and country shells and any natural objects, for their Kindergarten room.

PREPARATORY CLASS.

In this class Kindergarten methods, especially objective teaching, must be largely used.

SCRIPTURE.—Bible stories about Moses, Joseph, Daniel, Jacob, Abraham, etc.

TEXTS TO BE MEMORIZED—*God is love. God is our hope. Let us love one another. Overcome evil with good. The Lord's Prayer. Matt. V., 3-11—The Beatitudes Luke VI., 31—The Golden Rule. Psalm XXIII.—The Lord is my shepherd, etc. Psalm XXIV.—The earth is the Lord's, etc. Prov. XVI., 32—He that is slow to anger. Ephesians VI., 6—Not with eye service (Busy work.) St. Luke II., 40—And the Child grew. St. Luke II., 8—And there were (Christmas.) Prov. III., 6—In all thy ways (New Year.) Song of Solomon II., 11-12—Lo, the winter is passed (Seasons.) Gen. VIII., 22—While earth remaineth (Seasons.)*

All the above need not be taken. Little children must be trained to commit to memory perfectly.
