

that deceit, corruption, or violence, can become a measure of State Policy. In a real Republic, which is *Res Populi*, the Proceſſion of its conſtitution, and the courſe of its actions, ariſe from Nature and Truth; all Deception, all Corrupt influence, all Violence, is directly contrary to the true principles of politics. Without Truth and Juſtice, a Republic cannot be adminiſtered or governed. The Supreme Magiſtrate of ſuch a free State, muſt, from the nature of his information, ſee things as they lie in Nature, and will of Courſe found his Meaſures in Truth. Truth is not only a virtue, but is Wiſdom; and, in a government of a real Republic, ſuch as the Empire of America, is the only Genuine Policy. It creates truſt, finds Union and Confidence. And, laſtly, an Adminiſtration actuated by ſuch principles and maxims, finds itſelf *Clothed with Strength*, the united ſtrength of the People.
