Algiers Plan Attack on French Posts in November.

Algiers, Algeria, Oct. 14.—Despatches received here from the interior show that the local situation is growing in seriousness.

Arrangements have been made that every section of the population according to its numerical ability and the malcontents are to meet in November at Oued Ghir, two days' march from Colomb-Bechar, and attack at once the French posts in the southern district.

How to Make Safe the Money in Banks

In an article in The New York American on "To Make Safe the Money in Banks," W. W. Newberry says: Do you ever worry about the safety of the money you have deposited in the bank? Do you realize that such a small sum as 45 cents per annum would insure against loss \$1000 deposited in a national bank?

We approach so closely to making absolutely safe money deposited in banks and there is so much to be gained as such a comparatively small cost annually reasonable to suppose that at no distant day the final steps will be taken and the safety of deposits made certain.

The moral effect of a bank failure, which reaches far beyond the financial sufferer, is to be dreaded more than the actual financial loss. The commercial disasters, which usually follow in its wake, are caused more by delay in the depositors receiving what is due them than by ultimate loss, which, as a matter of fact, is extremely small.

With the failure of the Ontario Bank a month or two ago, several new territories have been suddenly opened. As a result it is already announced that the Canadian Bank of Commerce will open branches at once in Lindsay and Kingston, in the latter city on Tuesday in a prominent building, which has been leased, while a special despatch to the World from Cornwall says: "Following the transfer of the Ontario Bank to the Bank of Montreal it is announced that a branch of the Royal Bank will be opened here to-morrow at 10 a.m. with A. Denny, late manager of the local Ontario Bank, as manager, and R. A. Pringle, M.P., as solicitor."

The Royal will also open a branch at Peterborough. Cornwall, too, Cornwall will have a branch of the Bank of Commerce. Alex. Laird, assistant general manager of the Bank of Commerce, speaking to The World, said that it was merely a matter of business.

"We have long thought of establishing branches in Lindsay, Kingston, Cornwall and in other places, but we have had to wait for the right opportunity where we are free to act. We don't intend to do anything to the detriment of the business of the bank, but the Ontario Bank is in liquidation anyway, and we are simply entering the field which is vacated."

According to a Kingston despatch, four different banks have branches in the city Saturday anxious to close terms with A. J. Macdonell, manager of the Ontario Bank. To join their staffs and open up branches of their institution in the city. No announcement yet made by Mr. Macdonell.

Some \$100,000 or \$150,000 was withdrawn by depositors during the day. The nervousness of the people, in regard to Ontario Bank troubles, is manifested in market gardeners to-day.
