CASE FOR INVESTIGATION.

Carter, the Caretaker of Riverdale Park, Sends a Young Woman to the Cells in the Patrol Wagon

PLUCKED A BRANCH OFF A BUSH

Was Seized and Arrested Because She Declined to Tell Her Name—Clergyman's Kind Art

Because Mary Adams, a domestic employed at a Rosedale home, plucked a branch off a willow bush in Riverdale Park yesterday afternoon and refused to tell her name and address to a man in plain clothes, she was sent to the Court-station and there charged with theft. The arrest was made by Edwin H. Carter, the caretaker of the park, who is also a special constable. It was said that she saw the woman pluck the branch from the bush and then immediately seized her. After a little questioning the woman declined to make known her identity and Carter charged that she only way he could compel her to give her name was by placing her under arrest. At the sight of the patrol wagon the young woman broke down and told who she was. An Anglican church minister who happened to be present with the young woman's employer, and about 8 o'clock, after spending five hours in the cells, she was released on bail to appear in court this morning. Any caretaker of a public park who acts in a disrespectful and high-handed manner, such as the foregoing is said to be, is totally unfit to fill his position. The police said that night that it was a record case for high-handed behavior.
