Supreme Court Declines to Review Decision of Judge in Expropriation Proceedings.

Ottawa, May 29.—(Special.)—An appeal was taken from the judgment of three-quarter length, smart styles, the garment for showery days, for ags or for traveling. ustice Sedgewick in chambers in the supreme court this afternoon in the ase of the Grand Trunk Railway Co. case of the Grand Trunk Railway Co.
v. Williams, refusing leave to appeal from a decision of the board of railway commissioners. The only matter argued in the case to-day was whether or not the court had jurisdiction to review such a decision by a judge. Mr. Shepley, for the appellant, contended that it was an inherent right to review any decision of a judge. Mr. Ewart and Mr. Cowan for the respondent argued that there is no such inherent jurisdiction, that the judge is persona designata, and that he nly exercised his judicial discretion with which the court would not interfere. Judgment was reserved on the goint as to jurisdiction, arguments on the merits to be heard later if the jurisdiction exists.

Glyn Osler appeared for the City of Toronto, an interested party in connection with the proposed changes at the Union Station, and Hon. A. G. Blair for the board of railway commissioners, neither taking any part in the arguments on the points raised.
