SAYS MANUFACTURING IS ADVANCING WHILE FARMING STAGNATES

Calgary, Oct. 4.—(By Canadian Press).—Manufacturers and the agricultural interests of the province presented arguments before the tariff commission at the session in the city hall today.

The morning session was occupied by the reading of statements and the presentation of arguments on behalf of the manufacturers, who claimed that the industrial growth of Calgary was made necessary and possible by the protective tariff. Agricultural interests, on the other hand, held that development of the land resources of the Dominion are being retarded by the preference given the industries by the tariff as it exists.

H. W. Woods, president of the United Farmers of Alberta, held that agriculture had been forced into a secondary position and manufacturing into an abnormal primary position by the tariff.

Sessions of the commission will be continued here Tuesday.

Manufacturers Grow. In relative proportion Mr. Woods claimed, manufacturing production had grown up to 1919, thirty-seven per cent more than agricultural production. He claimed that manufacturing industry no longer needs protection, and that the tariff should be lowered.
