OUR LEADER IN VACUUM CLEANER VALUES is this electric cleaner called the Ohio. It is a combination suction cleaner and carpet sweeper that can be attached to any electric bulb and applied to any part of the household furnishings, no matter what it is, and in double quick time all dust and dirt is removed from the article.

No dust is whirled and swished through the air to lodge on other furniture. The high speed motor propels a fan at a speed of about 10,000 revolutions per minute, sucking up the dirt with amazing quickness and depositing it in the dust bag, where it cannot again escape.

Its Different Attachments Provide for the Cleaning of Every Possible Piece of Household Furnishing

The machine as it appears in large illustration on the left is used for cleaning rugs, carpets and floors. It glides over the thickest rug with the slightest touch and its lightness enables easy moving from step to step when cleaning the stairs.

So useful and handy is it too, that crumbs are quickly gathered up from the floor after each meal, lint and thread from the sewing room, or all signs of a house party are soon removed.

The small illustration above shows how it is used for conveniently bringing the dirt from the very depths of upholstered chairs, chesters, settees, etc. This same attachment can also be applied to curtains, portieres or for extracting dirt and dust from mattresses, etc.


Another very handy and useful attachment is a brush that can be connected and used for cleaning clothes, cushions, blinds, curtains, etc.

There is still another accessory to this machine that can be attached and used for reaching under radiators, stoves, heavy furniture, beds, pianos, etc. This same connection is also used for blowing and airing pillows and cushions.
