Owing to the wonderful popularity of the score of "Madame Sherry," and to the fact that many of its song hits, especially "Every Little Movement Has A Meaning All Its Own," have been played, hummed and sung everywhere for months, the impression is current that the appeal of this sensational success is chiefly musical. But such is not the case, for its mirth qualities are quite as engaging as its musical score. An idea of the comic possibilities of "Madame Sherry" may be gained from a glance at its list of characters, which include a fussy old uncle and his pleasure loving niece, a New York man about town, a Spanish beauty, a temperamental South American, a French janitor and his spouse, a lively dancer and several others.

EGG RECIPES

Baked Eggs, Madrid Style—Make a cup of thick tomato sauce, or chop the canned or stewed tomato fine without straining it, seasoning it with onion juice, salt and pepper. Mix with this a couple of link sausages that have been cooked and chopped into small pieces; pour the mixture into a dish and break

upon it as many eggs as the space will allow without crowding; set in the oven and cook until the whites of the eggs are firm.

Baked Eggs with Ham—Add a teaspoonful of onion juice to a cupful of finely chopped boiled ham; beat six eggs with a little pepper—no more salt will be needed than is supplied by the ham—

a tablespoonful of minced parsley, and turn the mixture into a frying pan in which is a tablespoonful of melted butter. You can either stir the mixture as you would for scrambled eggs until the eggs thicken, or you may cook it as the bottom with an omelet knife and folding it when done. In either way it is very good.

Eggs a la Lausanne—Add a small onion, minced very fine, a couple of stalks of chopped celery, and salt and pepper to taste to a pint of stewed tomatoes in which the hard lumps have been broken or chopped. Heat it to the boil and let it cook for 10 minutes. Have six eggs well beaten; stir these into the tomato puree, cook for five minutes, and serve.

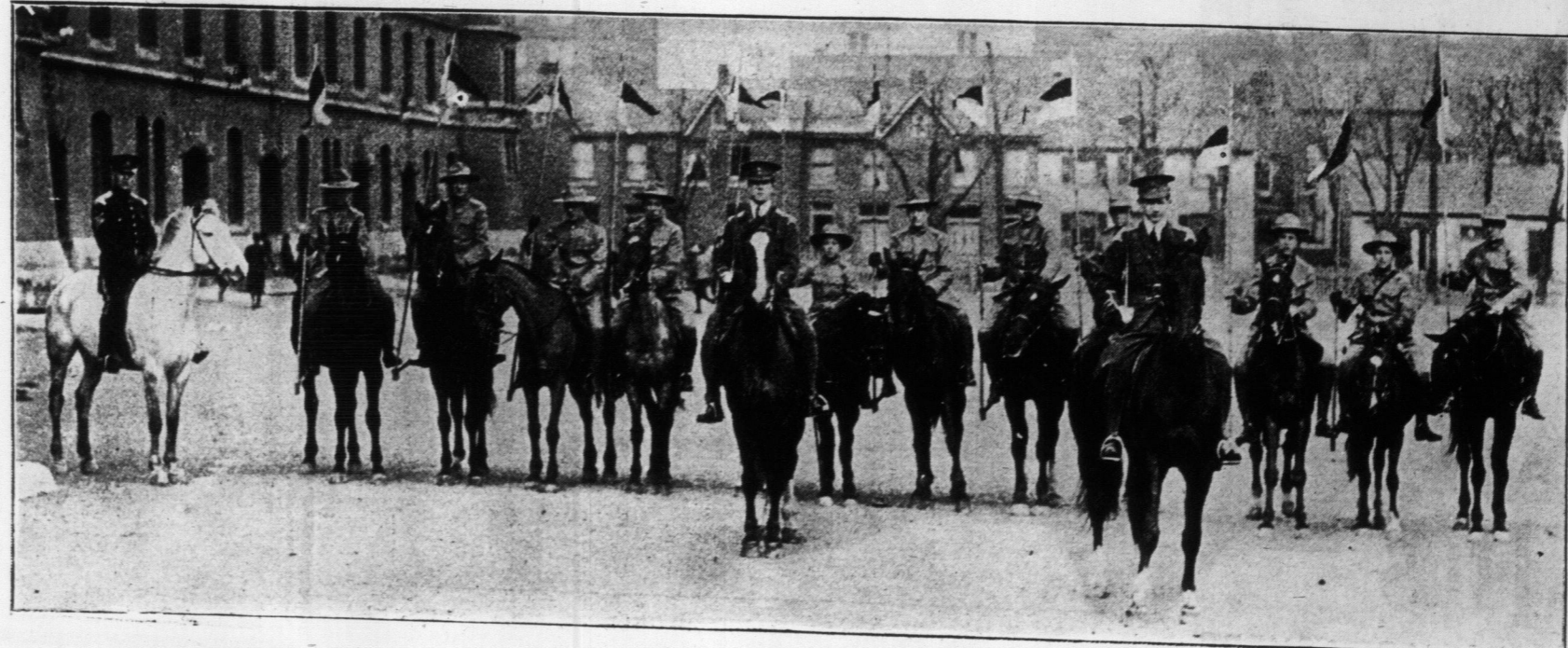
