treaty for our prayers, as well as for our gifts; and the new and formidable barriers which are presented by a recreant and degenerating Protestantism, by a refined pantheism and trancendentalism, and by pestilent forms of absurd superstition, swarming amid the very harvest field of our labours, urge the duty upon us with admonitory solemnity. Brethren, it is our safety, as well as our success, which depends upon our prayers. Let the whole church, then, prostrate herself in the dust, and, in solemn and imploring accents, send forth the incessant cry,-'Arise, O God, plead thine own cause. Remember how the foolish man reproacheth thee daily. Forget not the voice of thine enemies. God be merciful unto us and bless us; and cause his face to shine upon us; that thy way may be known upon earth, thy saving health among all nations. Let the people praise thee, O God; let all the people praise thee. Then shall the earth yield her increase, and God, even our own God, shall bless us.
