THE FORTY-FOUR HOUR WEEK

The most important problem confronting the International Typographical Union at this time is putting into effect the forty-four-hour week on the first day of next May.

That this Joint Conference Council considers that all members of its constituent bodies are morally bound to adopt and put into effect the forty-four-hour week on May 1, 1921.

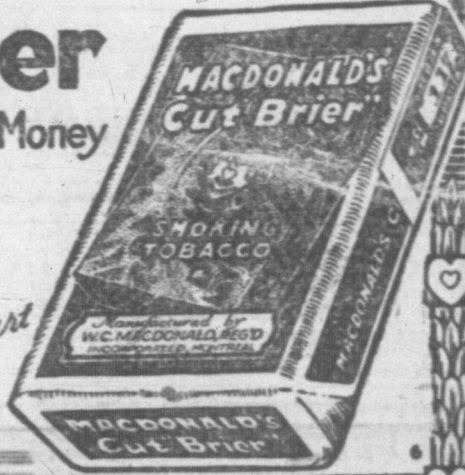
