

The Liberal ministers, after hesitating whether to challenge a fight with the lords by a dissolution, either on the budget or on some other programme, have decided on sticking to office, carrying certain non-contentious social reform measures for two or three years, disregarding the evidence of growing dissatisfaction and the by-elections and making an attempt to carry bills which the lords will not accept.

BUSINESS SLUMP

1908's Decline in Trade the Heaviest on Record.

Official Figures Which Show the Almos Unrelieved Commercial Depression of the Year.

LONDON, Feb. 3.—It hardly needed the convincing statistics just published by the British Board of Trade to demonstrate that the industrial crisis through which this country is passing has earnel for 1908 the name of "the

has earnel for 1908 the name of "the year of the great slump."

The official figures furnish a record of twelve nonths of almost unrelieved commercial depression. British imports in 1908 amounted to \$2,965,703,615, a decrease of more than \$263,000,000 as compared with 1907, and the exports were \$1,886,096,895, a loss of over \$244,-00,000, the heaviest decline ever recorded in any one year of British trade.

The full significance of these figures can be better understood when the shrinkage in Pritish imports and exports of manufactured articles during 1108 are noted. With unemployment increasing, in every branch of trade British manufactured goods sold abroad dropped to the extent of nearly \$225,000,000, while foreign made goods suffered a decline of about \$59,000,000. At the same time the United Kingdom bought \$189,000,000 less raw material, which should go to feed British factories and


