ABSTRACT STATE OF THE CHURCHES. — [CONTINUED.]

The reader, by carefully looking at the above Table, will see at a glance the name of the Church; the name of the Clerk; the name of the Pastor; the year of his settlement, and the proportion of the time he spends with the Church; the name of the Church, and the statistics of the Sabbath School. The fraction indicates the proportion of time where the whole is not spent.
