CHAP. VI.

An ORDINANCE

Declaring what shall be deemed a due publication of the ordinances of the province.



It is ordained and enacted by his excellency the captain general and governor in chief of this province, by and with the advice and consent of the legislative council of the same, THAT the printing and publishing of any ordinance of this province in the *Quebec Gazette* shall be deemed a sufficient publication thereof; and all ordinances heretofore published as aforesaid, are declared to have been thereby duly published.

Ordained and enacted by the authority aforesaid, and passed in council under the Great Seal of the province, at the council chamber in the castle of St. Lewis in the city of Quebec, the fourth day of March, in the seventeenth year of the reign of our sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third, by the grace of God of Great-Britain, France, and Ireland, King defender of the faith, and so forth, and in the year of our LORD one thousand seven hundred and seventy-seven.
