

N.S. M, June, 1877, Adelia, dau. of James Hayden, Esq., of Vernon River, P.E.I. Called to the Bar, P.E.I., 1872. First returned to Ho. of Assem. for present seat at g.e. 1879. Sworn of the Ex. Coun., and apptd. Provl. Secretary and Treasurer, 11 March 1879. Resigned his portfolio 3 March, 1880. Re-elected at g.e. 1882, 1886 and 1890. On the appt. of Hon. W. W. Sullivan to the Bench, became Premier and Attorney General of the Province Nov. 1889, and was Leader until April 1891 when his Govt. resigned. A Liberal-Conservative.—*Charlottetown, P.E.I.*

MCLELLAN, Hon. BERNARD D. (*Prince, 1st Dist.*)

S. of Angus J. McLellan of Indian River, P.E.I., and nephew of Hon. John A. Macdonald, Speaker of the Ho. of Assem. B. at Indian River, 3 Nov., 1859. Ed. at St. Dunstan's Coll., Charlottetown. M., 17 Oct., 1881, Emily, dau. of the late Michael Costin. of Palmer Road. A farmer. Was a School Teacher for nine years. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at bye election held 15 March, 1888, and re-elected at last g.e. Apptd. Speaker of the Ho. of Assem. April 1891. A Liberal.—*Palmer Road.*

McMILLAN Hon. ANGUS. (*Summerside.*)

Is a merchant. Sat in Ho. of Assem. from g.e. 1876 to g.e. 1882, and was a member of the Council in 1878. Re-elected at last g.e. Apptd. a mem. of the Ex. Council and Provincial Secty, Treasurer, and Commr. Public Lands, 22 April 1891. A Liberal.—*Summerside.*

MONTGOMERY, JOHN MALCOLM. (*Prince 3rd District.*)

B. at Princetown, 4 Jan, 1843. Ed. at Fanning Grammer Sch.. Malpeque. M. at Cavendish, Mary Emily McNeil. A farmer. Was Usher of the Black Rod in the Leg. Co. from March, 1887 to Jan. 1890. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g.e. 1890. A Liberal.—*Princetown, P.E.I.*

MCWILLIAMS ALFRED. (*Prince 2nd District.*)

Is a merchant. An unsuccessful candidate at bye election Sept. 1873. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at bye election held 9 April, 1891. A Liberal.—*West Point, P.E.I.*
