13 & 14 Vict...113	An Act to continue and extend the Montreal and Lachine Railroad, and to incorporate the St. Lawrence and Ottawa Grand Junction Railway Company.—Under this Act the Montreal and Lachine Railroad Company are bound to commence the extension of the road within three years (10th August, 1853), and to complete it within ten years from the passing of this Act, that is, by .....	10th August, 1860.
	But in the event of their inability to do so, the St. Lawrence and Ottawa Grand Junction Railway Company are required to commence the Railroad within three years from the expiration of the time allowed the Montreal and Lachine Railroad Company to commence it (10th August, 1856), and to complete it for public use within ten years from that time, that is, by .....	10th August, 1866.
13 & 14 Vict...114	An Act to authorize the Company of Proprietors of the Champlain and St. Lawrence Railroad to extend the said Road, and for other purposes.—The branch and continuation authorized by this Act, to be completed within six years, that is by .....	24th July, 1856.
13 & 14 Vict...116	An Act to incorporate Peter Paterson, Esquire, and others, under the name of "The Quebec and Richmond Railway Company."—The road to be completed within ten years, that is by..... But see 18 Vic., c. 33.	10th August, 1860.
